The Highland Water District will require a "trench inspection" before applicant backfills the water service from the curb box to the house, and a "meter inspection" after installation of the water meter and remote reader. These inspections are free of charge, unless appointments for such inspections are missed or the inspection fails. Any subsequent inspections or appointments for inspections are priced as follows:

2 nd inspection	\$50.00
3 rd inspection	\$100.00
4 th inspection	\$200.00
5 th inspection	\$300.00
